| Amercements 10s 4d   | They present that Master Howell Kerry (2s) drew blood from Jevan ap Jenkin; and the same Howell (12d) attacked the said Jevan; and the said Jevan (6d) assaulted the said Howell. And that David (6d), the servant of Philip Geffys, assaulted Margaret formerly the wife of William Watkis; and the said Margaret justly raised the hue and cry upon the said David (6d). And that John of Herdwyke chaplain drew blood from David Willis. And that Holkin Gam (6d) assaulted Henry Thomas of Edgton and Roger his brother. And John Wilkyn (6d) made a rescue upon the bailiff. And that Geoffrey de Poss (4d) unjustly raised the hue and cry upon John of Bourton. And Jevan Dewe (12d) of Kerry drew blood from David Smith of Kerry. And David Vaughan (4d) wounded John le Deire. And Holkin Gam (12d) drew blood from a certain Walter. And that Joan Dyer (2d) sold ale; Margaret [?Margery] Penny (2d) did the same; and that Joan (6d) wife of Roger of ? [did the same]; and Margaret [?Margery] Foley sold ale; and Agnes Stephens (2d) did the same.
